- "Cancelled Events" - Prom, Spring Sports, Field Day, Trips, Conferences.
 - In one school in CA the Senior Class trip was cancelled and the money was used to buy every student a book.
- "Travel Restrictions" maybe the coverage is designed more like a "Magazine" style layout.
- "Concert" in your homes and online.
- "Flattening the Curve" isn't a jog on the treadmill.

Other Tips:
